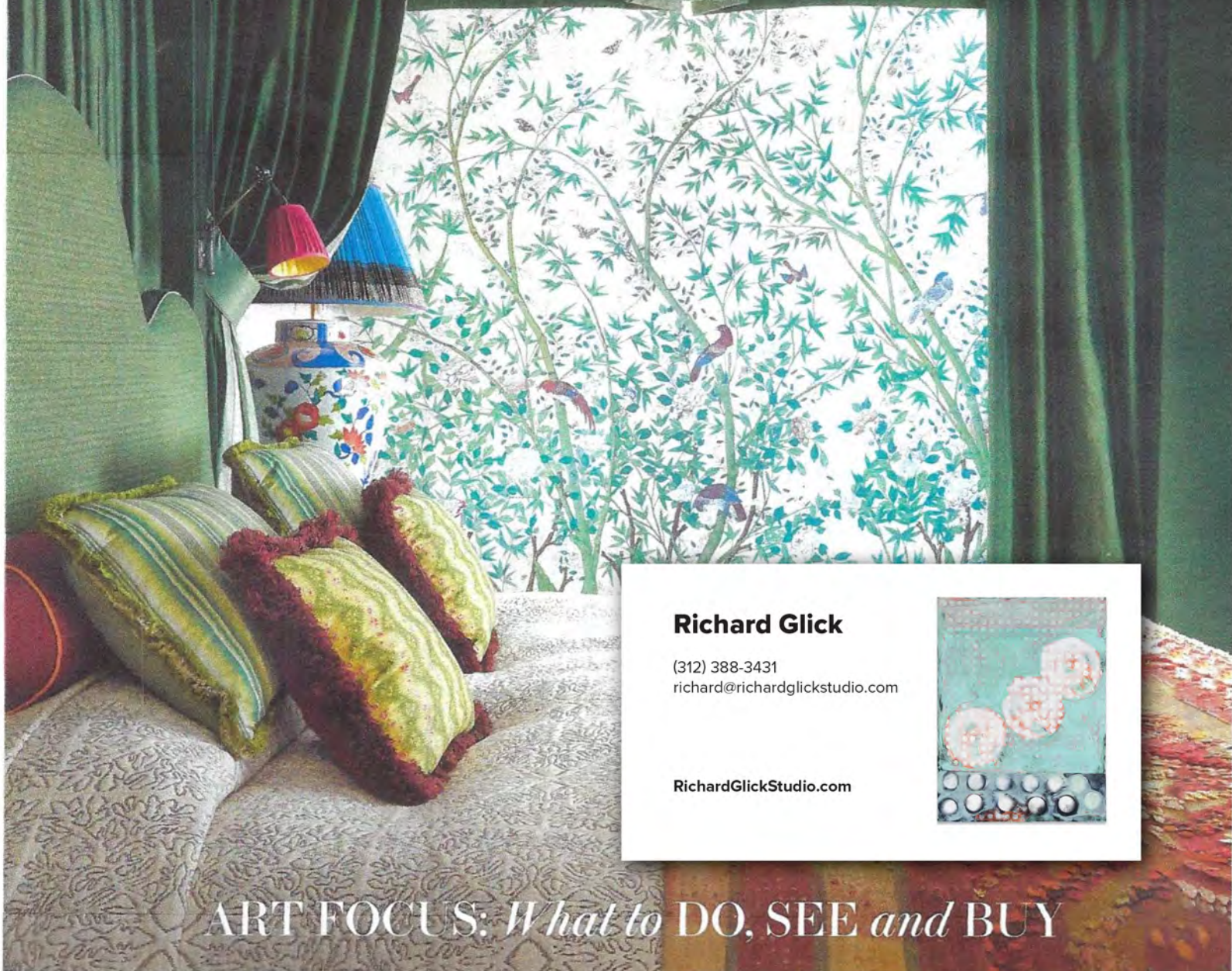

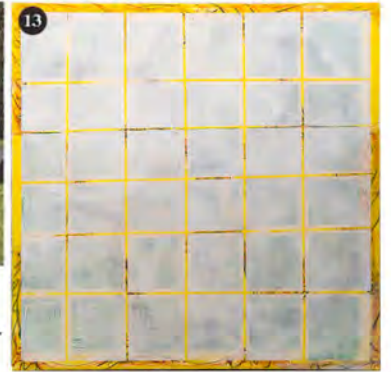
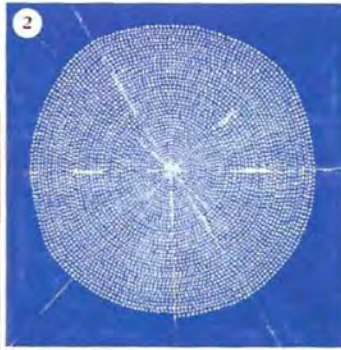

1. **KAITLIN KRAEMER** uses vivid colours and dramatic brushstrokes to create large-scale abstract paintings in oil. Her recent work focuses on the concept of time, and the variety of emotions we experience with each passing day – inviting viewers to take a pause, reflect, and
